DRONE: Unmanned Aviation Operator Training

This course is a beginner level training experience designed for the Public Safety, First Responder, Fire, and Law Enforcement Professional. About This Course

The UAOT LEVEL-1 TRAINING COURSE is a 4-DAY (32-HOUR) interactive training experience geared towards the successful mastery of basic small UAV / Drone operations within a first responder and public safety mission set. This full immersion unmanned aviation flight course provides nearly twenty hours of instructional flight time, with approximately twelve hours of classroom modules for learning. This course is designed at the beginner level, and therefore prior experience is not necessary. Core fundamentals of this course will require students to both examine and interpret intelligence and acquisition planning, as well as perform practical exercises staged towards successful completion of tasks in the face of complex requirements and even technical or environmental adversity. Students will master basic aviation strategies, as well as the appropriate and safe use of unmanned flight platforms within the guidelines and regulations established by law and policy. This course includes specific focus on the deployable roles and responsibilities of pilots, operators, forward observers, and visual observers alike. If you or your agency are seeking the "Gold Standard" for unmanned flight, this course is for you. Completion certificates will be issued for students who satisfactorily master all required aspects of this course. This course does not have a prerequisite for enrollment.
