The FBI 40 hour Basic Crisis Negotiation Course is a week long course that teaches the fundamentals of crisis negotiation and gives the student tools to approach any crisis situation regardless of their prior experience in these types of situations and whether they are a first responder, emergency dispatch operator, a tactical officer, commanding officer, or other law enforcement officer. Classroom teaching will be mixed with real world case study applications, audio and video incidents from around the country along with scenario training utilizing role players to engage, challenge, and expose each student to each function and role in which crisis negotiators are presented with during an actual crisis situation.
